

Release Notes for Raritan PX2 Firmware Version 3.2.30

Version: PX2 3.2.30 Build 43188 Release Notes, Version 2

Date: June 14, 2016

Effective: Immediately.

Applicability:

This firmware release is for General Availability (“GA”) on all existing Raritan PXE, PX2-, PX3-, PX3T, BCM2 and EMX2 models. Use the User Guide for PX2 3.2.10 with this release. Release 3.2.30 contains all enhancements and fixes which are listed [below](#).

Some custom engineered models are not supported by this release. Please check the **Not Supported in This Release** section [below](#). Or, contact Raritan Support if you are unsure of the model number of your unit; it is typically viewable from the GUI *Device Information* page, and is printed on a label on the side of the PDU.

Please do NOT upgrade ANY other Raritan PX model(s) to PX2 3.2.30 because the unit may have been built after this release entered System Test, and it may result in the unit becoming non-functional.

Please do NOT downgrade your new PX2/PX3 firmware based models to any prior release, as these models may not be supported in previous firmware versions.

Caution: Only Power IQ releases 5.0 and higher are compatible with PX2 3.2.30.

Due to significant internal enhancements in PX2 3.2.30, you cannot downgrade from Release 3.2.30 build 43188 to ANY prior release. Please contact Raritan Support with any questions.

Release Status: General Availability (GA)

Release 3.2.30 contains all enhancements and fixes which are listed below:

- 1) Support new AMS segment design [63101]
- 2) Support new DPX3-T1H1 sensor [60156]
- 3) OpenSSL updated to release 1.0.1t [63968]

Known Issues with this release

1. AMS-M8Z SNMP assetStripCascadePosition wrong [64276]

For AMS-M8Z asset strips, the ASSETMANAGEMENT-MIB reports an incorrect value for assetStripCascadePosition

Please note that the firmware file for the EMX2 model is different than the PXE, PX2-, PX3-, PX3TS and BCM2 models.
